Why Recycle?

Closer look at recycling benefits through:

- ✚ Avoidance of disposal costs.
- ✚ Reducing the amount of waste that must be disposed – reduce incineration costs and less landfills
- ✚ Preventing or reducing air and ground water pollution.
- ✚ Conservation of precious natural resources – since fewer raw materials need to be extracted and processed.
- ✚ Saving energy and making us more sustainable because we are borrowing less materials and energy from our children's future.
- ✚ We will be protecting our health as well as the environment if we recycle



Adopt waste prevention policies

- ✚ Why buy recycled materials.
- ✚ How to incorporate source reduction objectives into procurement policy guidelines to decrease the amount of waste generated.
- ✚ How to encourage manufacturers to develop and sell products that create less waste, and often save money.
- ✚ Benefits of purchasing reusable items instead of single-use items, such as flatware, mugs, dishes, trays, coffee filters, salt and pepper shakers and bulk containers for sugar, mustard, and ketchup and avoid individually wrapped servings.
- ✚ Buying in bulk, such as cleaning products, food products, and office supplies.
- ✚ The use of soda fountain dispensers, milk in steel containers, and water coolers to decrease use of disposable beverage containers, and purchase other beverages.
- ✚ Identifying local options for composting organics and rendering fats and grease are available.
